

Millennium Farms Arrival Check List

Thank you for choosing to board your horse with Millennium Farms! We look forward to working with you. In order to make your horses' arrival as smooth as possible, below is an overview of our boarding requirements

Before your horse arrives, you must send:

- Current Vaccinations – EHV 1-4 **MUST** have been given within 90 days of arrival. List of current vaccinations and date given is required prior to arrival.
 - Please be aware that recommended vaccinations are different by region and Kentucky may have different specifications than your horses' previous location. If you have any questions or concerns about the vaccination schedule, please feel free to contact our team.
 - Required vaccinations:
 - Annual- **Botulism**, EWT, Rabies, Strep, West Nile
 - EHV every 90 days, Rotavirus- once a month for 3 months pre-foaling
- Special instructions for your horse- please notify the team if there are any special feed, medication, or handling concerns for your horse
- Contact information for you and your agent (if applicable)
- Insurance information- Company, bloodstock agent, and policy number
- When shipping arrangements have been made, please notify the team of the estimated date and time of arrival, as well as van company you are using.

For your horse to be unloaded, it must have:

- Current Coggins
- Identification- **CORRECT** name on halter, neckstrap, tag, etc.
 - If your horse does not have permanent ID already, please attach some form of temporary ID (shipping tag, tape with name, etc) and notify the team so we can have proper identification ready.

Information for your van driver:

- We require all vans arriving during business hours to first stop at the office before unloading horses
- Van driver is to call Jose Rodarte (859-509-0623) when they are 30 minutes away
- If arriving between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. please call Jose by 8 p.m. with an estimated time of arrival

For any horse that fails to meet the above criteria upon arrival, Millennium Farms reserves the right to vaccinate, perform necessary diagnostic tests (PCR, Coggins, etc) and/or quarantine the horse, at the owner's expense. This is for the safety of your horse and all others boarded at Millennium Farms.
